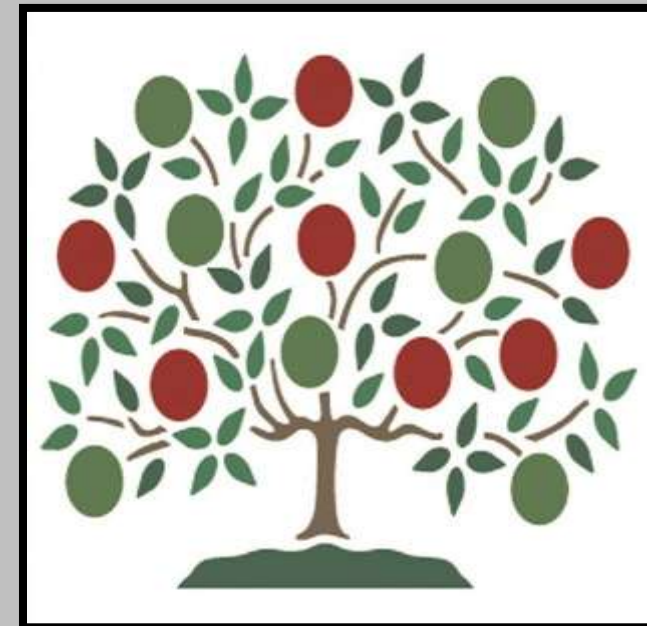

This collaborative process of ongoing empowerment and development includes the individual, friends, family members, guardians, natural supports, CEI-CMH and the community.

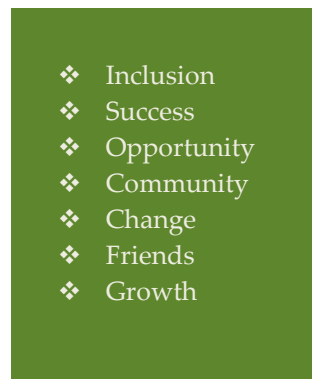


Services Offered

Programming consists of individual and/or group activities which focus on skill building onsite and in the community. Progress in these areas is documented. Program options may include the following services and supports:
